## 1. Where are you using the Ramp?

- Used for easier access in and around the home or workplace, ideal for climbing kerbs and similar obstacles (select Personal)
- Used for climbing larger steps and higher kerbs than the Personal model Great for commercial or travelling situations (select Multipurpose)
- Used for where the doorway is between 75cm and 82cm, and is a great solution for loading unoccupied equipment into the rear of a vehicle (select Senior)
- Used for access to shops, offices and government buildings, and where unassisted on long ramps or where there are any risks involved, ie would you feel more secure with edge barriers on your ramp (select an EBL)



## 2. Measure and calculate total step/kerb height you will be needing

## 3. Refer to our Ramp Calculator and determine if there is an appropriate Ramp length at 4 degrees (AS/NZ standards)

## 4. You need to complete a risk assessment to see if an increased angle gradient is suitable

- Ensure there is a suitably trained person to assist in the risk assessment
- Consider if the Ramp will be used with Power or Manual equipment
- Consider if the Ramp will be used with Manual assisted or unassisted equipment
- If a new selection is determined as suitable, move to Q5



## 5. Check that the ramp, once folded, fits into your transport requirements

## 6. Will you occasionally travel to locations you're unfamiliar with? Consider the multi purpose model which comes with a bag & weighs only 4kg (this may be an additional Ramp requirement)
